RESOLUTION TO ENACT LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF 1976

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. 4 OF 1976
REDUCING PER CENTUM OF REAL PROPERTY
TAX EXEMPTION ALLOWED BY SECTION 485-b
OF THE REAL PROPERTY TAX LAW

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Board of the Town of Thurman, New York as follows:

SECTION 1. The per centum of exemption of real property in the Town of Thurman from real property taxation allowed by Section 485-b of the Real Property Tax Law of the State of New York for any and all real property defined in said Section is hereby reduced to zero per centum (0 %) .

SECTION 2. A copy of this Local Law shall be filed by the Clerk of the Town of Thurman forthwith with the State Board of Equalization and Assessment.

SECTION 3. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
